



# Beginning of 'Arab Spring' Tunisia Revolution(Jasmin Revolution)

- \* Failed economic policy → High unemployment / Inflation
- \* Government riddled with corruption
- \* Revelation of Wikileaks spread quickly on the Internet and SNS
  - Revealed the extent of corruption among the ruling Ben Ali family
  - Criticism and accusations of US diplomats
- \* Self-immolation of street vendor Mohamed Bouazizi


# **Development of 'Arab Spring'**

#### Tunisia Revolution(Jasmin Revolution)

- \* Extended street protests and the growing unwillingness of the army to fire on protests
- \* As a result, Ben Ali family were forced to flee Tunisia for Saudi Arabia

These successful Tunisian revolutions triggered flame of resistance throughout the Arab region.

# **Role of Media in 'Arab Spring'**

National media outlets in each country disregarded the events. (excepting Al Jazeera)

- \* But, New media technology enabled real-time circulation of images, videos and messages through the internet and social media(facebook, twitter, youtube).
- Demonstrators recorded the events with their mobile phones, and shared their videos with people in the country at larege and around the world via YouTube and Facebook, often with live streaming.
- Organizing demonstration, disseminating or discussing news of the events locally and globally
