Interactivity


'Stands for a more powerful sense of user engagement with media texts, a more independent relation to sources of knowledge, individualized media use, and greater user choice'

Three levels of Interactivity

- 1. Interactivity with the medium itself, as with hyperlinking to other web sites
- 2. Interactivity with other users through the medium, as on social media sites and online discussions forums.
- 3. Interactivity as engagement with social institutions, as when the medium is used for deliberative purposes.
